## **UCR Auto-Renew Program**

In the first year of UCR's auto-renew program over 21,000 carriers signed up to have their 2025 registration automatically renewed by the NRS. These carriers receive emails to remind them of the upcoming automatic registration. These registrations will all be done with option A and use the number of power units on their most current MCS-150 form. Payment will be automatically completed through the credit card the carrier authorized on the NRS during their 2024 registration.
