New FMCSA Entry-Level Driver Training Regulations Take Effect February 7, 2022

A new Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) rule sets federal training standards for commercial driver's license (CDL) applicants. Starting February 7, 2022, entry-level commercial motor vehicle drivers will be required to complete training with a registered training provider taking certain commercial driver's license skills or knowledge tests.
