Annual Carrier Audits Due As of July 1



States participating in the UCR program are required to conduct an annual audit of their carriers. As of July 1, 2020, states should have completed their assigned carrier audits for the 2019 registration year in the admin portal of the National Registration System. Please continue to perform carrier audits for the 2019 registration year that are assigned in the NRS and <u>FARs website</u>.

FMCSA Issues Alert on Broker and Carrier Fraud and Identity Theft



Fraud and identity theft occur when entities use another motor carrier's assigned USDOT number, when not authorized to do so, or when someone acts as a broker and is not registered with FMCSA. The FMCSA has issued an alert providing information on preventing identity theft and fraud as well as steps to take if you suspect that you have been the victim of fraud or identity theft.
