UCR Updates Recommended Fee Levels for 2023

The UCR Board of Directors submitted its recommended fee levels for the 2023 registration year to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) on August 26, 2021. On January 24, 2022, the FMCSA published in the Federal Register its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, which followed the Board's recommendation. Now that six months have elapsed since the Board's initial fee recommendation, the UCR Board has updated its official recommendation with more current financial data. The updated fee levels recommended by the UCR Board during the public comment period show a slight decrease from the original August 26, 2021, recommendation.

New Report Available for State Employees

State employees who work in the National Registration



System (NRS) admin portal can now access "should-havebeen" reports, which show when a motor carrier who is not UCR-compliant gets pulled over without receiving a ticket for UCR noncompliance.

Complete State Carrier Audits by March 31



States participating in the UCR program are required to conduct an annual audit of their carriers. All states must complete their audit by March 31, 2022.

Final audit reports must be submitted through the admin portal of the National Registration System by **June 1, 2022.**
