State Carrier Audit Reports Due By June 1



States participating in the UCR program are required to conduct an annual audit of their carriers. The Audit Subcommittee will view final audit reports in [the admin portal of the National Registration System \(NRS\)](#) on **June 1, 2022**.

UCR wants to help make state carrier audits as efficient as possible. This is a good opportunity for state employees, whether or not they have attended previous audit training sessions, to learn how to conduct the annual state carrier audit required of participating states, how to navigate the Focused Anomalies Review (FARs) and National Registration System (NRS) tools available to state employees, and more—or to brush up on those skills and learn about new tools available to conduct audits.

The UCR Board has authorized reimbursement for travel expenses under the federal travel regulation rates and requirements for one trainee from each state in addition to all members of the Audit Subcommittee.

Conflict of interest policies outline procedures for when a possible



conflict exists between personal interests and the interests of an organization. UCR's Conflict of Interest Policy (1) defines conflicts of interest; (2) identifies classes of individuals within the UCR covered by this policy; (3) facilitates disclosure of information to help identify conflicts of interest; and (4) specifies procedures to be followed.
