UCR Policy Spotlight: State Performance Standards



UCR participating states agreed to be bound by a set of requirements needed to fairly enforce the UCR Act and the UCR Agreement. Accordingly, these states are required to undergo periodic compliance reviews, administered by, and with oversight from the UCR Audit Subcommittee and UCR Board of Directors. Contained in the State PerformanceStandards are those standards that states are expected to reasonably be able to demonstrate compliance with.
