Register Now for the 2022 Registration Year

Registration for the 2022 UCR registration year is open, with <u>no fee changes</u> from the 2021 registration year. <u>Use UCR's Decision Tree</u> to check whether your business is required to register and, if so, <u>register</u> by January 1, 2022. Registration for the 2020 registration year (except for state audit purposes) ended on September 30, 2021, at 5:00pm EDT.

UCR Policy Spotlight: State Performance Standards

In order to participate in the UCR program, a state was required by the UCR Act to file an election with the Secretary of the USDOT



within three years after the Act became law. Any state that did not make an election was barred from joining UCR. A state that made an election to participate agreed to be bound by a set of requirements needed to fairly enforce the UCR Act and the UCR Agreement.
