Registration for the 2023 UCR registration period is officially open, and fees have been reduced from the 2022 registration year <u>as published in the federal register</u>. Use <u>UCR's Decision Tree</u> to check whether your business is required to register and, if so, <u>register</u> by January 1, 2023. Enforcement for the 2023 registration year is recommended to begin on January 1, 2023.

As set out in the Unified Carrier Registration Act, Congress determined that the dispute resolution function was to reside primarily in the UCR Board of Directors, rather than in the courts, which are not, on the whole, well-suited to dealing with these issues.
