Registration for the 2022 UCR registration year is open, with <u>no fee changes</u> from the 2021 registration year. <u>Use UCR's Decision Tree</u> to check whether your business is required to register and, if so, <u>register</u> by January 1, 2022. Registration for the 2019 registration year has closed (except for state audit purposes).

UCR Policy Spotlight: State Audit Requirements

Participating states are required to perform audits each year on carriers who retreat from one payment bracket to a lower payment



bracket, to verify that the company has properly deducted vehicles from its UCR payment. If a carrier neither pays what the state shows it to owe nor justifies its retreat, the state shall, pursuant to the requirements of due process, determine to suspend the carrier's current year UCR registration, pending the carrier's acceptable compliance noted in Step 1 of the the mandated audit sequence.
