2023 UCR Registration Period Now Open with Reduced Fees

Registration for the 2023 UCR registration period is officially open, and fees have been reduced from the 2022 registration year <u>as published in the federal register</u>. Use <u>UCR's Decision Tree</u> to check whether your business is required to register and, if so, <u>register</u> by January 1, 2023.

Unified Carrier Registration Plan Board of Directors; Request for Nominations

UCR Policy Spotlight: Written Information Security Policy (WISP)



The purpose of this WISP is to:

- (a) Ensure the security, confidentiality, integrity, and availability of personal and other sensitive information the UCR Plan collects, creates, uses, and maintains.
- (b) Protect against any anticipated threats or hazards to the security, confidentiality, integrity, or availability of such information.
- (c) Protect against unauthorized access to or use of UCR Plan-maintained Personal Information that could result in substantial harm or inconvenience to any individual.
- (d) Define an information security program that is appropriate to the UCR Plan's size, scope, and business, its available resources, and the amount of Personal Information that the UCR Plan owns or maintains on behalf of others, while recognizing the need to protect information.
