# UCR Policy Spotlight: UCR Guidance for School Bus

#### **Operators**

Correction: A clarification has been made in the last sentence of the Policy Spotlight.

UCR defines a commercial motor vehicle as a self-propelled vehicle used on the highways in commerce principally to transport passengers or cargo, if the vehicle:



- Has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of at least 10,001 pounds, whichever is greater, or
- when connected to trailing equipment has a gross combination weight rating or gross combination weight of at least 10,001 pounds, whichever is greater, or
- Carries placarded amounts of hazardous materials, regardless of the vehicle's weight, or
- Is designed to carry more than 10 passengers, including the driver.

Generally, the UCR Act does not allow for exclusion of vehicles used in the intrastate transportation of passengers. However, the Board has determined that a carrier primarily engaged in intrastate school-bus operations may exempt its intrastate school buses from its fleet count.
