UCR Policy Spotlight: Conflict of Interest



Conflict of Interest Policies outline procedures for when a possible conflict exists between personal interests and the interests of an organization.

The Unified Carrier Registration Plan (UCR) Conflict of Interest Policy: (1) defines conflicts of interest; (2) identifies classes of individuals covered by the policy; (3) facilitates

disclosure of information to identify conflicts; and (4) specifies procedures to be followed.

- 1. **Definition** A conflict of interest arises when a person in a position of authority over the UCR may benefit financially from a decision he or she makes.
- 2. **Individuals Covered** Persons covered by this policy include the UCR officers, directors, the UCR Administrator management firm, and members of management that enter directly into contractual relationships with the UCR.
- 3. **Facilitation of Disclosure** Persons covered by this policy will disclose or update the Chairperson of the Board of Directors of their interests that could give rise to

- conflicts of interest, such as substantial business or investment holdings that may conflict with the interest of the UCR.
- 4. Procedures for Managing Conflicts The Chairperson of the Board of Directors will determine whether to: (a) take no action; (b) assure full disclosure to the Board of Directors (c) ask the person to recuse from related discussions or decisions; or (d) ask the person to resign from his or her position in the UCR.
